



Position: Labor Doula

Program: Healthy Start

Supervisor: Doula Team Leader

Salary: Contract/Stipends

Description: The Foundation for Delaware County will contract and train members of the community to become labor doulas and provide birth support to families enrolled in its Healthy Start program. Candidates will be trained to work with families prenatally, during labor, and immediately after birth. Candidates must commit to completing all requirements for labor doula certification by March 2023. In addition, they must maintain certification and agree to contract through the entire grant cycle ending March 2024. Candidates must also commit to additional training from The Foundation of Delaware County and its affiliates.

Qualifications

- High school graduate or equivalent.
- Basic reading, writing, math, and computer skills.
- Strong interpersonal communication and organizational skills.
- CPR certification is required.
- Child abuse clearances as mandated by PA Act 33 are required.
- Valid driver's license and reliable transportation required.

Responsibilities:

- Provide emotional and physical support to birthing families enrolled in Healthy Start.
- Offer evidence-based information about pregnancy, labor, birth, breastfeeding, newborn care, postpartum adjustment for moms and babies.
- Help create a safe environment by working with other birth team members to meet medical needs during the laboring process.
- Support communication between parents and medical professionals.
- Assist the mother in preparation for birth by using non- medical, non-invasive techniques to support delivery of the baby.
- Provide support to the partner and family members as they prepare for the birth of a child.
- Work collaboratively with Healthy Start case managers to connect families to additional resources available in Delaware County and ensure continuity of care.
- Maintain confidentiality in accordance with HIPPA compliance and regulations
