The Delaware County Heroin Task Force and Partners for Success Coalition is excited to announce the Fourth Annual Community Day: Celebrating Prevention which will be held on Saturday, April 21, 2018, at Rose Tree Park, Media, PA from 11:00 AM-3:00 PM. We want to extend a thank you to last year's sponsors, who were vital to the success of the event. Community Day will serve as a "drop off" event to get unwanted, unused, or expired prescription medication out of our homes and off the streets, to help keep our community safe. At last year's event we were able to collect 75 pounds of medication. We hope you will consider sponsoring our event this year, allowing us to raise awareness and spread education to those who are 18-25 years of age and their families, regarding the dangers of prescription drug misuse and abuse. All donations are tax exempt.

According to the Drug Enforcement Agency (DEA), each day 2,500 teens try prescription drugs to get high for the first time. In 2016, 206 citizens died of an accidental drug overdose in Delaware County. These consequences are irreversible, and as a community we need to work together to prevent this growing health issue. In recognition of the toll the prescription drug and heroin abuse epidemic is taking on the community, Delaware County Council and the District Attorney formed the Delaware County Heroin Task Force (HTF) to address this public health concern and raise awareness. The Partners for Success (PFS) is a coalition formed to achieve quantifiable declines in state-wide substance abuse rates. The priority for PFS is to address underage drinking and prescription drug misuse among youth, young adults, and families. The Delaware County Heroin Task Force and Partners for Success Coalition is affiliated with community leaders, local hospitals and health systems, physicians and pharmacists, realtors, youth and parents, education professionals, and other organizations involved in reducing substance abuse throughout Delaware County.
