

Recently Retired Judge Joins Board of Foundation for Delaware County

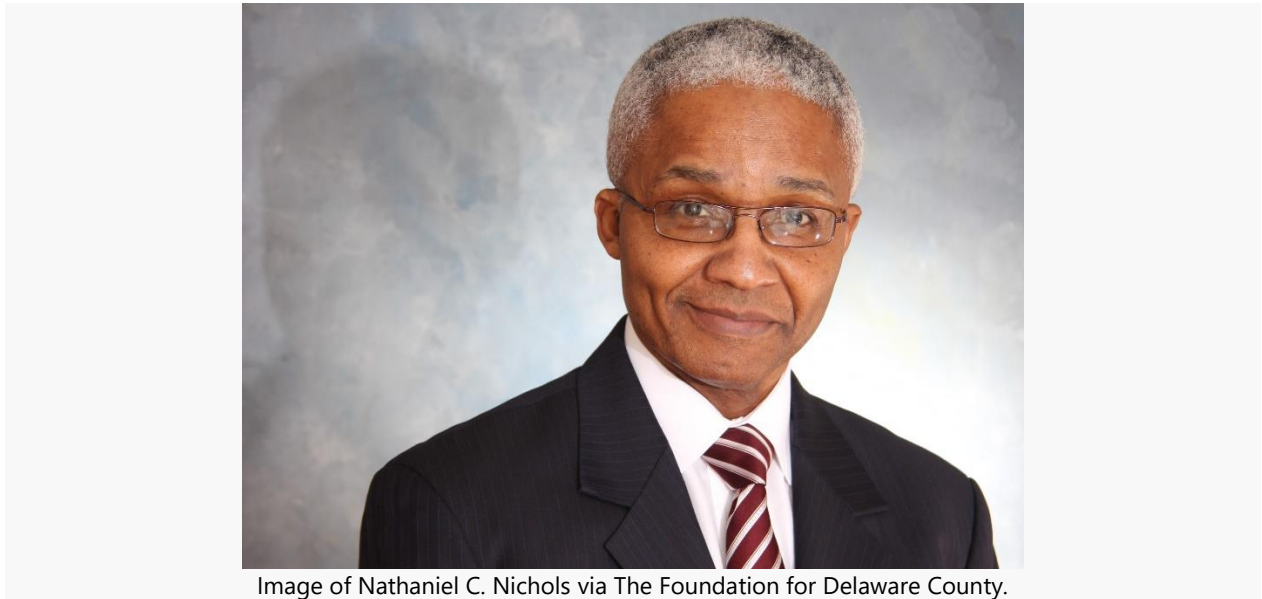
